

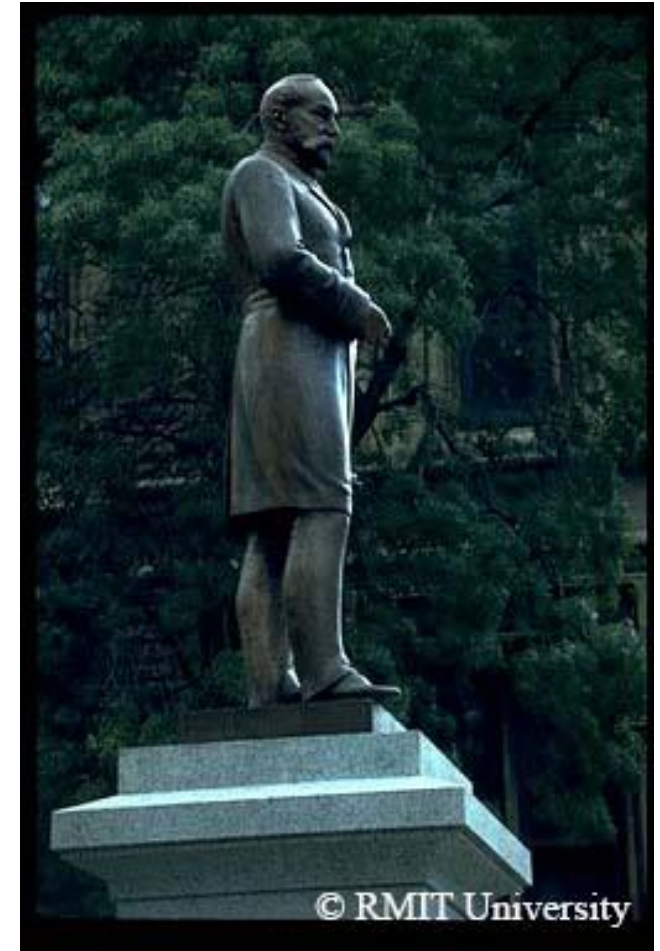

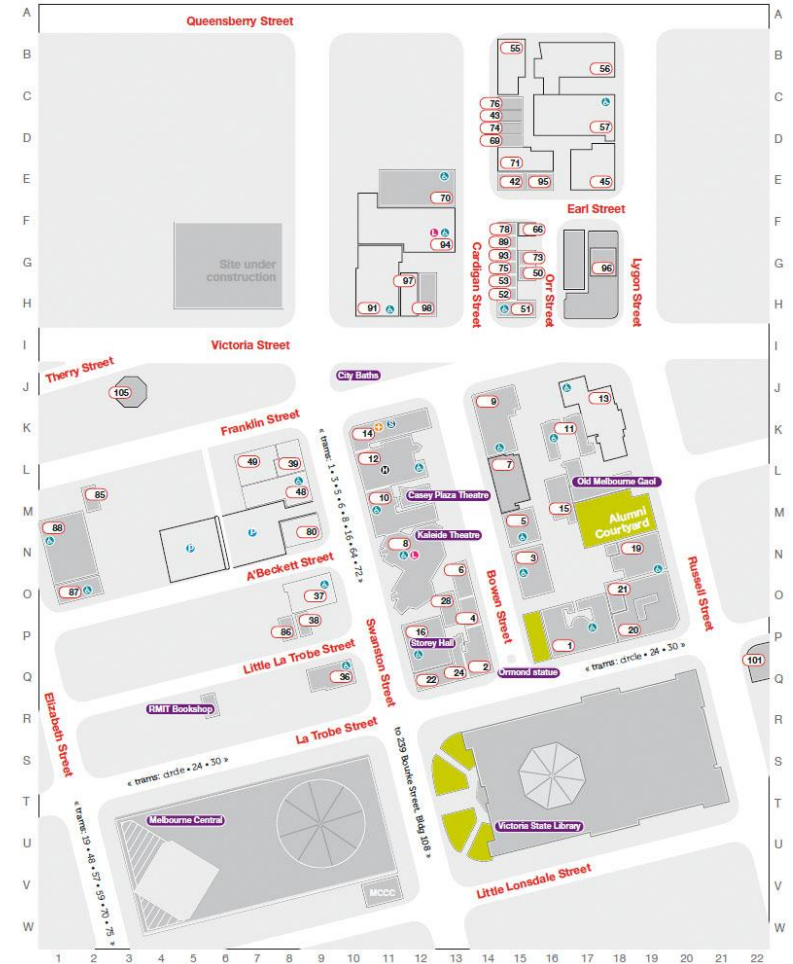

RMIT | Future RMIT Design Hub

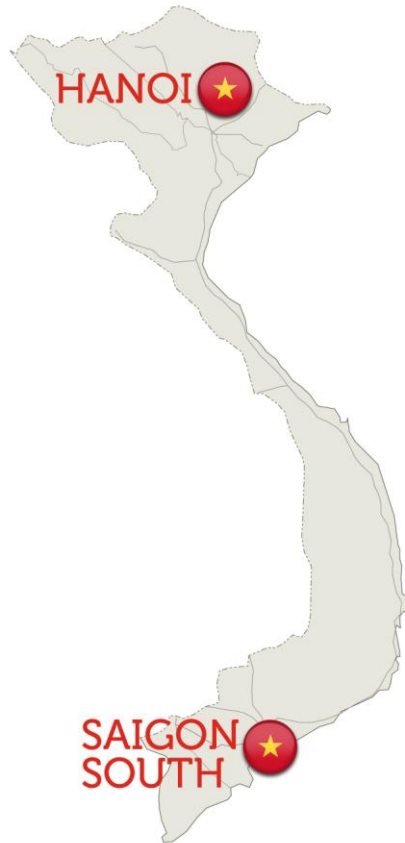

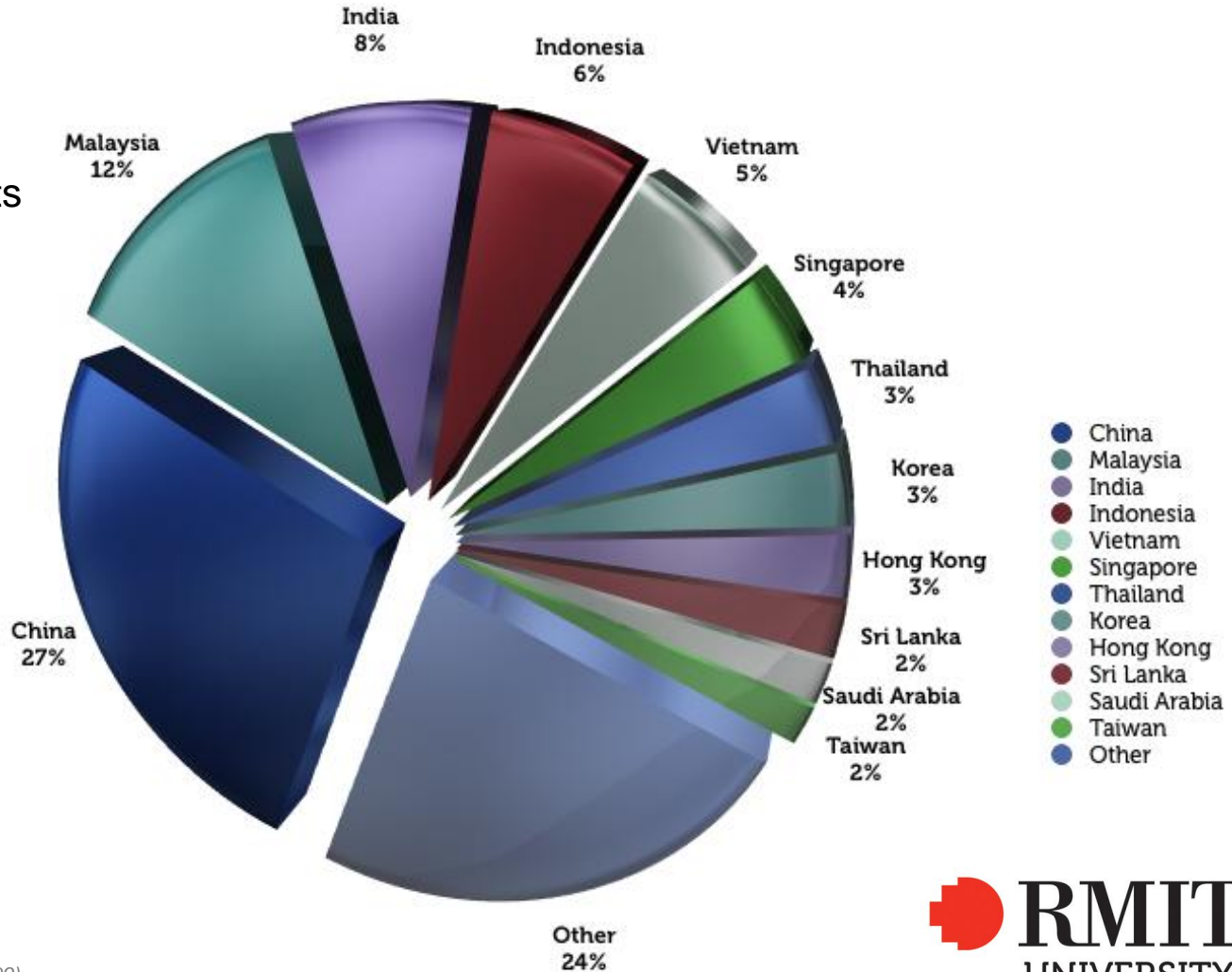

RMIT | RMIT International Industry Experience & Research Program (RIIERP)

- ▶ **Undergraduate work experience**
 - ▶ Students undertake work experience projects at international companies for periods of 6 to 12 months.
- ▶ **Graduate traineeship**
 - ▶ Provides new graduates with the opportunity to undertake industry experience projects at international companies for a period of 12 months
- ▶ **Bachelor thesis**
 - ▶ Provides students opportunity to carry out their theses in laboratories of partner companies/institutions.
- ▶ **Postgraduate research**
 - ▶ RIIERP used the state of the art research facilities of the partner companies to provide research infrastructure for RMIT students. Partner company provides co-supervision.

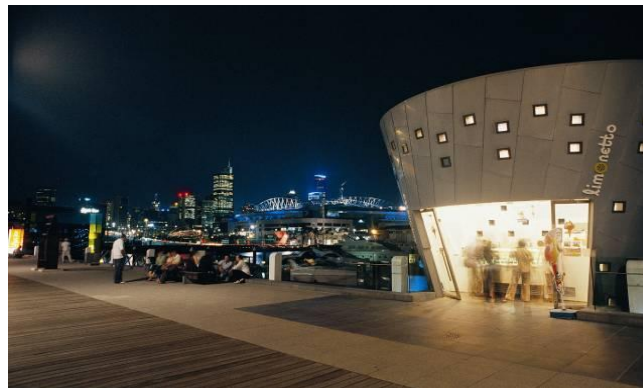

- ▶ English translation of transcripts required
- ▶ Provide a certified copy of syllabus if student is seeking advanced standing/course exemptions
